RE: Proposed works at Gnarabup Waste Water Treatment Plant

Water Corporation is undertaking an environmental site assessment at the Gnarabup Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) in Prevelly. . In accordance with the conditions set out in the Shire of Augusta-Margaret River Permit Works (Permit No. P220438), Water Corporation wishes to formally notify local residents, community members and the general public of proposed works scheduled to commence on Monday 24th through to 28th August 2020.

These environmental investigations relate to the monitoring of ground water and will assist in informing current and future planning and operations at the WWTP. This work is being undertaken to ensure ongoing compliance with the Licence requirements issued by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation under part V of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

Water Corporation has engaged environmental consultants Cardno to drill four new groundwater monitoring bores in the vicinity of the WWTP, including the sand dunes, immediately west of the WWTP. Groundwater bore installation will result in some minor impact to coastal vegetation west of the WWTP to enable the drill rig to safely access proposed bore locations.

With supervision from the Shire of Augusta-Margaret River Coordinator Environment/Landcare Services, the Corporation's contractors will traverse the vegetation utilising matting to minimise impacts to vegetation.
